Buy recycled paper towels instead of virgin rolls. If every household in the country did this just once, according to the Natural Resources

• Reduce:

Buy permanent items instead of disposables.

Buy and use only what you need. Buy products with less packaging.

Buy products that use less toxic chemicals.
