RECIPES TO SHARE

Pumpkin Seeds

2 cups pumpkin seeds ~ 2 Tbsp melted butter/margarine ~ 1 tsp salt

Mix together, spread out on a cookie sheet. Bake at 250° for 2 hours, or until brown. Stir every 20 minutes.

Non-Toxic Make-Up

1 part shortening ~ 2 parts corn starch ~ food coloring. Mix and apply.

Easy to Remove Make-Up

2 tsp cold cream ~ 1 or 2 drops food coloring. Mix with spoon and add more coloring if desired. Apply. Store unused make up in Midgets.

Halloween Popcorn Balls

1 cup white syrup ~ 1 small package orange Jello ~ ½ cup sugar ~ 9 cups popped popcorn

Mix Jello, syrup and sugar. Heat to boiling point, but do not boil. Pour syrup mixture over popped corn. Using buttered hands, form into balls. Jello flavor can be changed to fit the holiday.

Peanut Clusters

1 – 12 oz package semi-sweet chocolate chips (real)

1 – 12 oz package butterscotch chips (or 10 oz Peanut Butter chips)

Microwave in oval microwave cooker for 2 minutes. Stir. Microwave another 30 seconds if needed. Stir in 1 pound cocktail peanuts (or whatever nuts you'd like)

Drop onto waxed paper on cookie sheets. Put in freezer for 20 minutes.

Orange Ice Cream Jello

1 – 3 oz package orange Jello ~ 1 cup boiling water ~ 1 ½ cups vanilla ice cream

Put 1 cup boiling water and gradually add package of Jello into small bowl of Wonderlier Bowl Set (be sure it is dissolved well). Add ice cream. Put seal on bowl and shake well until ice cream is well dissolved. Refrigerate for approximately ½ hour before serving. (Can use 1 cup vanilla ice cream and 4 ice cubes instead of 1 ½ cups ice cream.) Light and refreshing!



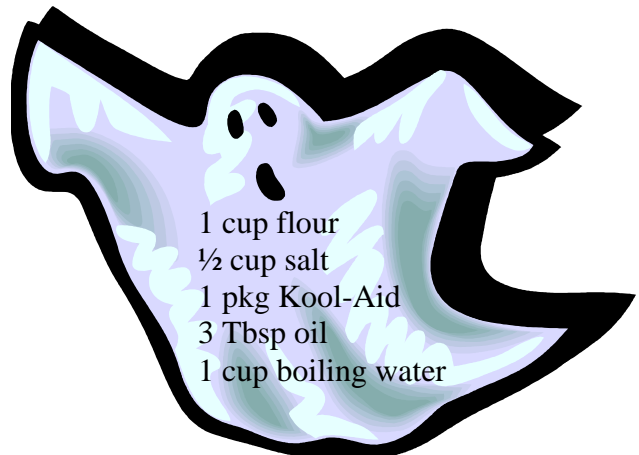
Treat for Your Trick or Treaters:

Build Attendance

Tell your host you will have a “treat” for each guest in attendance! Hand out small game prize as they come in the door. Offer a small gift to the Host when 13 or more are in attendance.

Demo Ideas

Decorate: Use a Halloween tablecloth, place small pumpkins or other related items around your display. Stickers work well, you can put one on an order form and whoever has it, gets a prize. Put Halloween candies in the Serving Center, then demo and pass around so guests can have a “treat”!

Centerpiece/Dessert: Make a Rice Krispy Pumpkin Cake for the centerpiece and the dessert. You will need these *products*: Vent N Serve Large Deep, Jel-Ring Mold, Measuring Cups, Utensil Set and Cake Taker (optional)
Ingredients: 2 Packages Marshmallows, 1 stick butter/margarine, 12 cups Rice Krispy Cereal. Black licorice (shoestring works well for the mouth)

Place 1 package marshmallows and ½ stick butter/margarine in Vent N Serve Large Deep, microwave on high about 1 minute and 30 seconds. Stir and add a few drops of orange food coloring. Add 6 cups cereal, and stir until well coated. Then pour or spoon carefully into a vegetable sprayed Jel-Ring Mold. Press down firmly, let cool. Flip out onto cutting board or Cake Taker. Then repeat with rest of the ingredients to make another. When both have cooled and flipped out, turn 1 upside down, just like when in mold, and place other on top. You can match up the ridges to make it look like a pumpkin. Take licorice and make a face. You may need to cut pieces on the cutting board if you can't find shoestring licorice.

Beverage: Bubbling Brew: 2 quarts apple cider, ¼ cup brown sugar, ¼ tsp salt, 1 tsp whole cloves, 1 tsp Allspice, 1-3 sticks Cinnamon (broken) Heat all together, serve hot.

Game Ideas

Place your game prizes in a non see through container, and attach orange & black ribbons to each one. Leave the ribbons hanging outside of container. Then each guest picks a ribbon and their prize is attached! Have each guest take a gift, then read the “Left & Right Halloween Story”. Each time you say left or right, they pass their gift to the left or to the right. Lots of fun!
